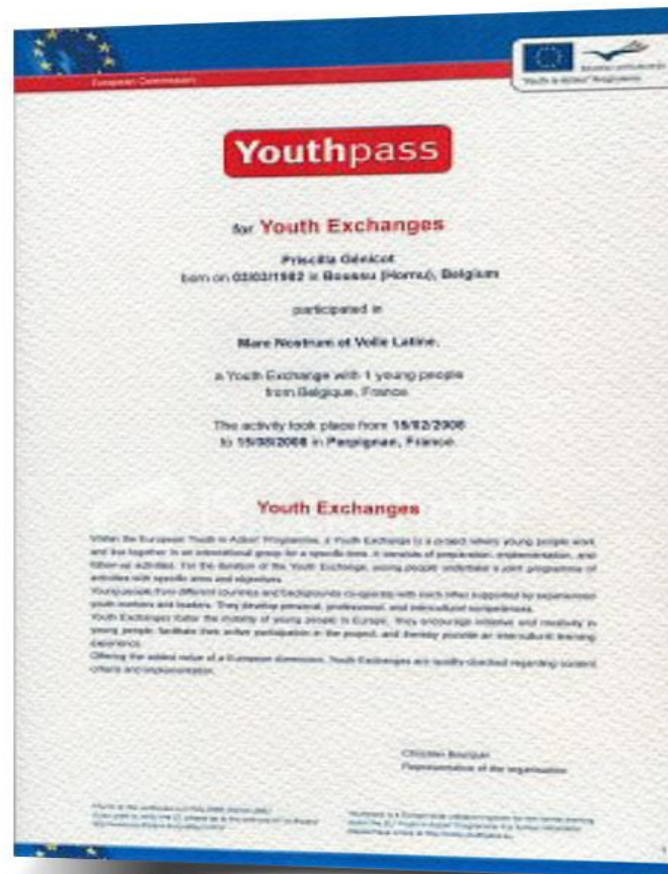

<p>EVS improves foreign language skills 97% of the EVS participants have learned to communicate better with people who speak a different language.</p>	<p>EVS improves intercultural competences 97% of the EVS participants have learned to get along better with people of a different cultural background.</p>
<p>EVS is an enrichment for local communities 92% of the EVS project leaders are convinced that the EVS was perceived as an enrichment by the local environment/communities.</p>	<p>EVS promotes solidarity, tolerance, respect and mutual understanding among young people More than 80% of the project leaders are convinced that the EVS project contributes (among other things) to young people's respect for cultural diversity, to the development of solidarity and tolerance and to fostering mutual understanding among young people in Europe.</p>
<p>EVS helps to realise one's ideas 74% of the EVS participants have improved their competences in developing a good idea and putting it into practice.</p>	<p>EVS helps identify future opportunities 80% of the EVS participants have gained experience in identifying opportunities for their personal or professional future.</p>

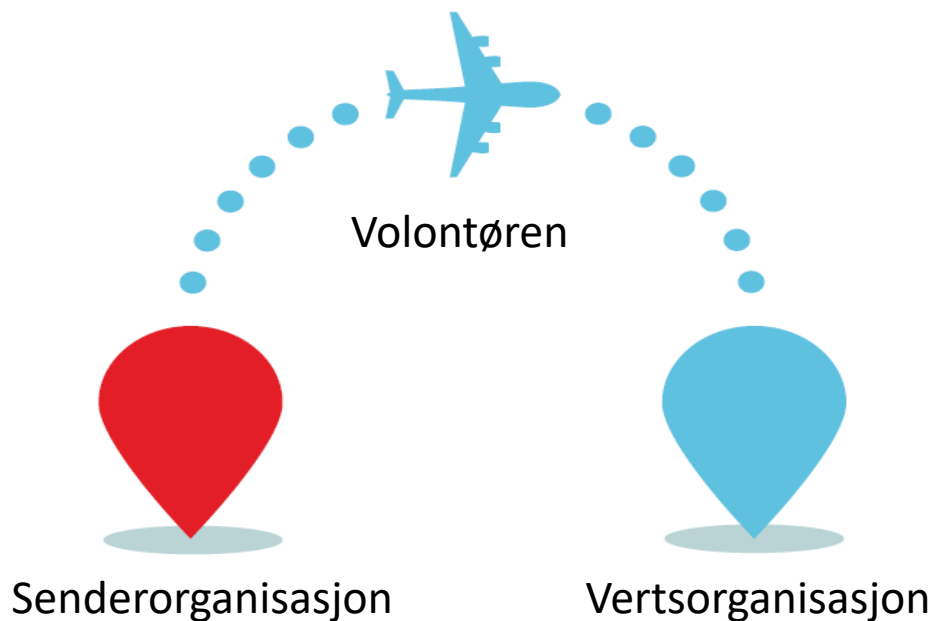



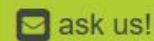
